

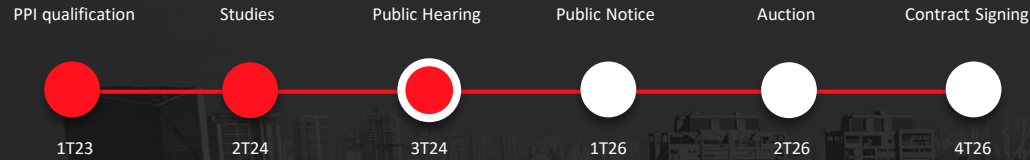

## PPP for School Renovation and Maintenance

- Public-Private Partnership by the Government of São Paulo for the renovation, modernization, and maintenance of 143 public school units across the state network.
- The project aims to ensure safe, accessible, and comfortable environments for students and teachers.
- An innovative contracting model that combines the efficiency of the private sector with the public management of education.
- The State retains full pedagogical responsibility, while the private partner manages infrastructure and support services.
