Solid Waste Management – Integra Resíduos Program

- Government of São Paulo project to develop regional and sustainable solutions for solid waste management and disposal.
- Involves 12 intermunicipal consortia, with 216 participating municipalities, which together generate about 7,000 tons of waste per day.
- An initiative by the State Secretariat for Environment, Infrastructure and Logistics (Semil) in partnership with the Secretariat for Partnerships and Investments (SPI).
- Objective: to ensure scale, economic viability, and energy recovery from waste.

IMPACT AND BENEFITS

- ❑ Extended landfill lifespan and reduction of environmental impacts.
- ❑ Incentives for recycling, composting, and energy generation (biogas and biomethane).
- ❑ Lower logistics costs and greater efficiency in waste management.
- ❑ Improved environmental infrastructure and support for municipal urban cleaning policies.
- ❑ Creation of green jobs and strengthening of the circular economy.
- ❑ Direct contribution to the State's sustainability and decarbonization goals.
