- An initiative that combines environmental preservation, ecological education, and regional development.

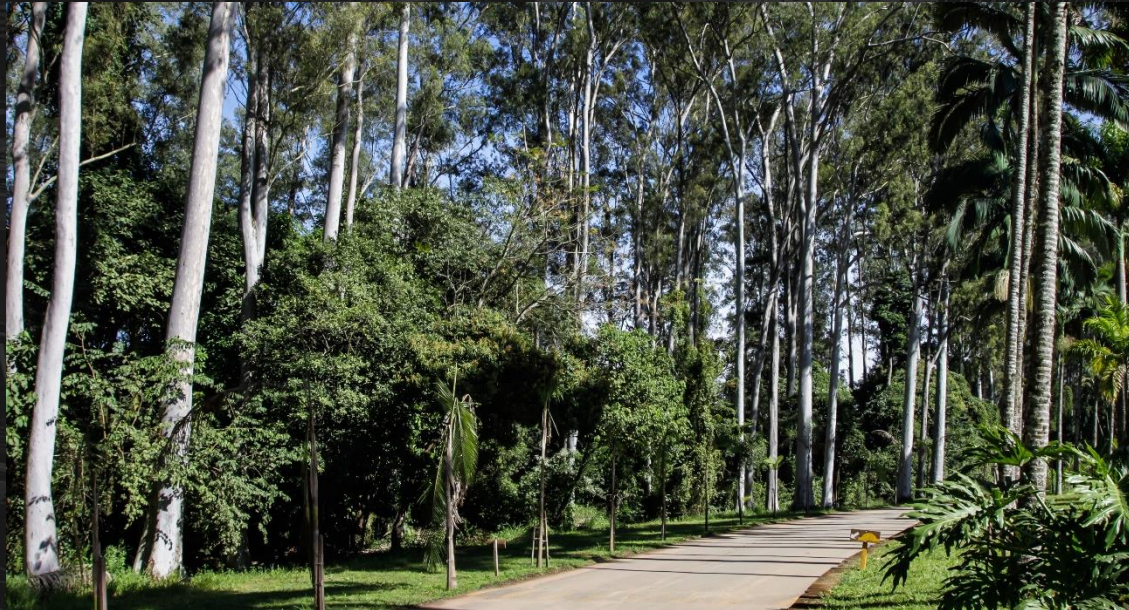
